<u>ABOUT THE CLASS</u>: The FLO course, sponsored by NTAC provides the necessary enabling tools to proactively develop, collect, retrieve, and disseminate information and intelligence pertaining to terrorism and multijurisdictional crime related issues, to identify terrorists or suspects engaged in ongoing criminal activities. How to identify precursor behaviors and activities associated with terrorism and or crimes, and the procedure for reporting suspicious activity information is discussed. The course is outlined as follows:

- 1. The creation of Fusion Centers.
- 2. The role of the Fusion Liaison Officer.
- 3. Behavioral Indicators/Seven Signs of Terrorism/Mobilization Indicators.
- 4. Information Gathering Baseline for Fusion Liaison Officers.
- 5. Critical Infrastructure/Key Resources (CIKR).
- 6. Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs).
- 7. Fusion Center Functionality and Operation(s).
- 8. Information Security; Civil Rights/Liberties 28 CFR Part 23.
